Update on the UIP Education Committee

At UIP2018, the UIP general council formally approved the formation of an education committee and voted for Dr Oscar Bottini from Argentina as the Chair. Dr Bottini has developed terms of reference for this committee, the outlining the composition, general guidelines, requirements to become member and committee structure, requiring the committee to have representation by at least one member from Europe/Africa, Asia/Oceania, North America and Central/South America.

The UIP received 50 applications to the committee were received and reviewed by the entire executive committee. From this list, 20 members were elected to the committee. The successful candidates are currently being notified, and the list will be made publicly available on the UIP website soon.

The UIP has received a number of bids to host the 2023 UIP Congress. These are being reviewed by the UIP EC, and will be presented to societies for voting during the General Council meeting in Cracow. Bids have been received by:

- Prague (Czech Republic)
- St Petersburg (Russia)
- Ekaterinburg (Russia)
- Basel (Switzerland)
- Miami Beach (USA)

Also for discussion in Cracow will be the changing of the congress structure to replace all future Chapter meetings with World Congresses.
