This brief newsletter is an update for the UIP Newsletter sent on [4 August, 2017](#). There was reportedly some confusion with regard to deadline dates for nominations for the UIP offices and the bids for the 2021 UIP World Congress, all of which will be voted upon in Melbourne during the General Council meetings.

The UIP Executive Committee will meet on 3 February, 2018. The UIP General Council will meet on 4 February, 2018 and again on 7 February, 2018. During the General Council meeting on 4 February, 2018 the vote will be taken on the UIP Reorganization proposals, the details of which were in the previous UIP Newsletters and are [available on the UIP website](#). If the proposals are approved, voting during the General Council meeting on 7 February, 2018 will include the traditional UIP officers' elections as well as elections for the new Education and Certification Committee Chair and the new Scientific Standardization Committee Chair, and the bid for the 2021 UIP World Congress.

So, to be clear, any nomination from a UIP Member Society in good standing (dues paid to date) for the positions of: President, General Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, Vice President (5), and the two new Committee Chairs must be received by the UIP President (Nick Morrison) and the General Secretary (Pier Luigi Antignani) by **4 October, 2017**.

Additionally, bids for the 2021 UIP World Congress must be submitted by the same date (4 October, 2017). Requirements for these bids may be submitted by any UIP Member Society in good standing and must adhere to the requirements available on the UIP website under the UIP tab – Appendix (<http://www.iup-phlebology.org/appendix/>). Member societies wishing to bid for the 2021 World Congress must understand that if the UIP Reorganization proposal is approved, the 2021 World Congress will be conducted under the new regulations as outlined at the General Council meeting in Rome in April, 2017 and in the most recent UIP Newsletter of 4 August, 2017
